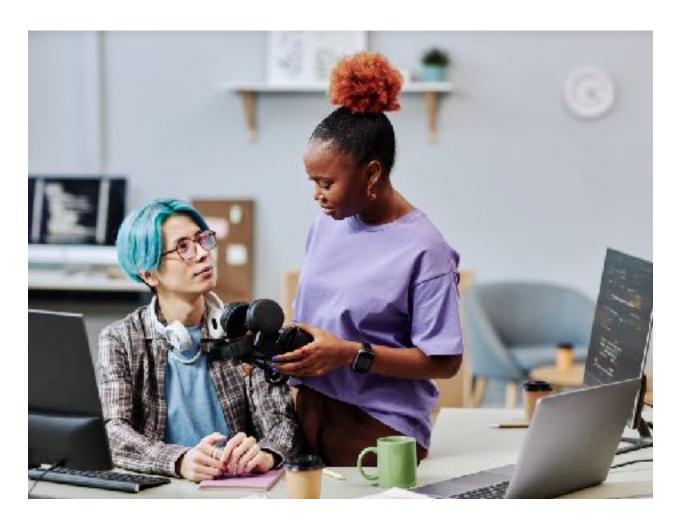

Hybrid Workplace Policy: Video Production and Podcasting



To foster creativity, collaboration, and high-quality output, Tech News (HK) has adopted a hybrid work model tailored to the specific needs of our video production and podcasting teams. This policy outlines the guidelines for in-office and remote work arrangements.

In-Office Work Requirements

Video Production and Podcasting Teams

- Core Team Members: Key personnel involved in video production, audio engineering, and podcast hosting are required to be on-site during specific production days or time blocks.
- Production and Recording Sessions: All production and recording sessions, including pre-production, recording, and post-production, must be conducted on-site to ensure optimal audio and visual quality, as well as effective collaboration.

- Communication and Collaboration: Remote workers must maintain regular communication with on-site team members through video conferencing, instant messaging, and project management tools.
- Equipment and Technology: Remote workers are responsible for providing their own reliable internet connection, computer, and necessary software to perform their duties effectively.
- Remote Work Hours: Remote workers must adhere to the company's standard work hours and be available for virtual meetings during designated times.

Hybrid Work Arrangements

- Flexible Scheduling: For roles that allow for flexibility, hybrid work arrangements can be considered, with a combination of in-office and remote work days.
- **In-Office Collaboration Days:** Regular in-office collaboration days can be scheduled to foster team bonding, brainstorming sessions, and knowledge sharing.
